

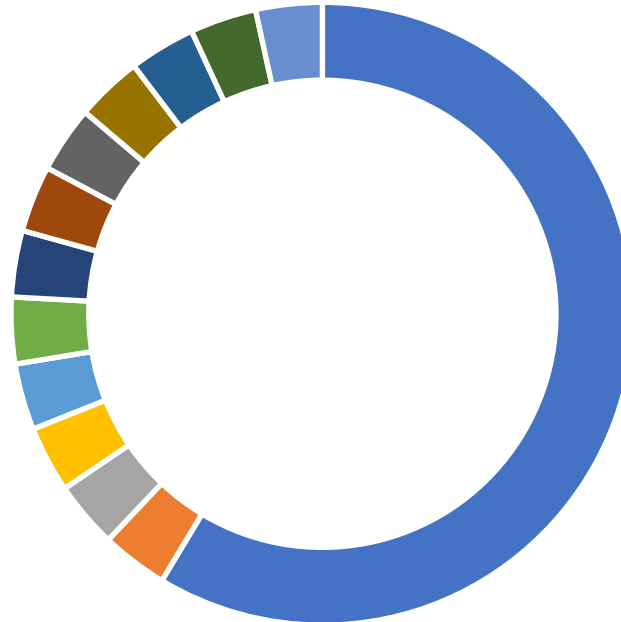

- Handicap parking-where will it be? Some of the old "visitor" spots would be perfect-right between the new parish hall and the old. The parking lot around the building needs cleaned up and the ramp at the far end of the building is difficult to access.
- Low priority: Consider adding a few low maintenance planters on the parking side of the new hall to add green space to the asphalt and brick. Also add low maintenance large pots with plants on either side of north door to new hall. Low priority: Design a cabinet to hold all of the outreach collection bins, such as yarn, food items, special collections like items for hospice house, laundry love, etc.
- Landscaping, we can't continue to have mud, the eyesore of the neighborhood. Is there a plan that I am not aware of?? And the lake in our gravel parking lot.....can we get a few loads of gravel to make this useable? Playground, expansion?? Not complaining asking if plans are in place and what is proposed.
- The detail about future plans for the current office.
- A welcome area is needed at the west end of the old parish hall (with chairs) for people to gather with friends before services. The new parish hall is to far for some older less mobile people. Also a work area for alter guild and flower team
- SOUND in parish hall should be a priority. Have to yell to be heard

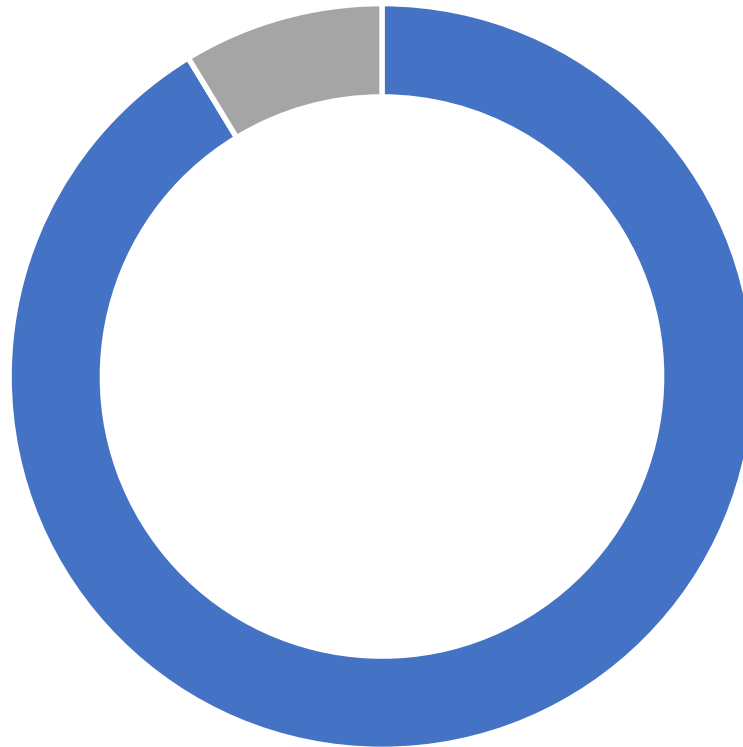
Generally speaking, do you favor the parish conducting a fundraising effort as outlined in the proposed plans?

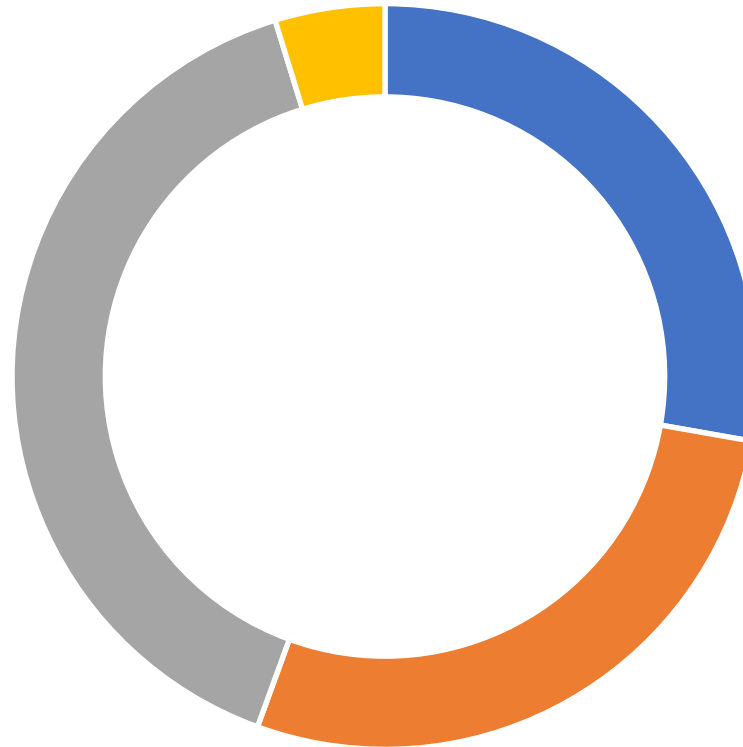
If you have concerns, please let us know what they are.

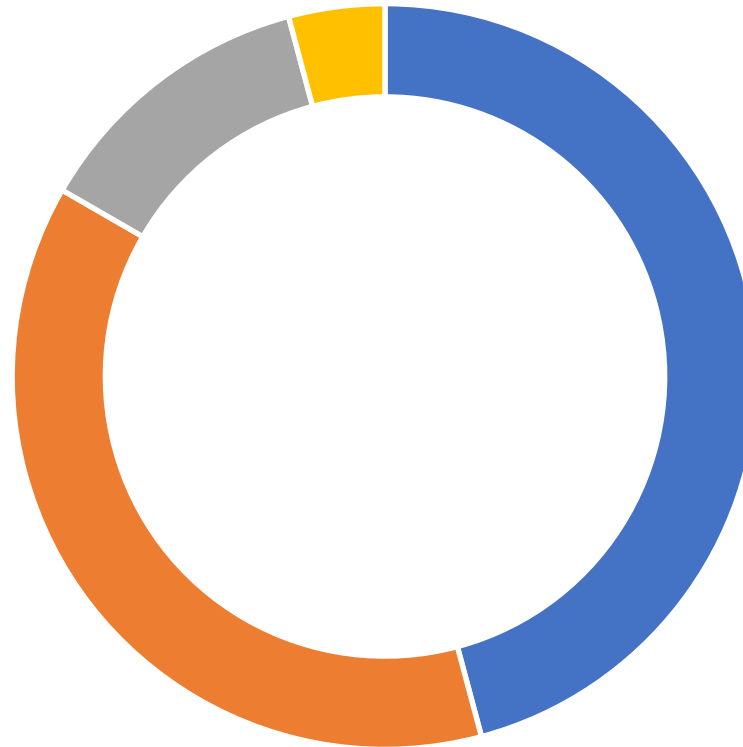

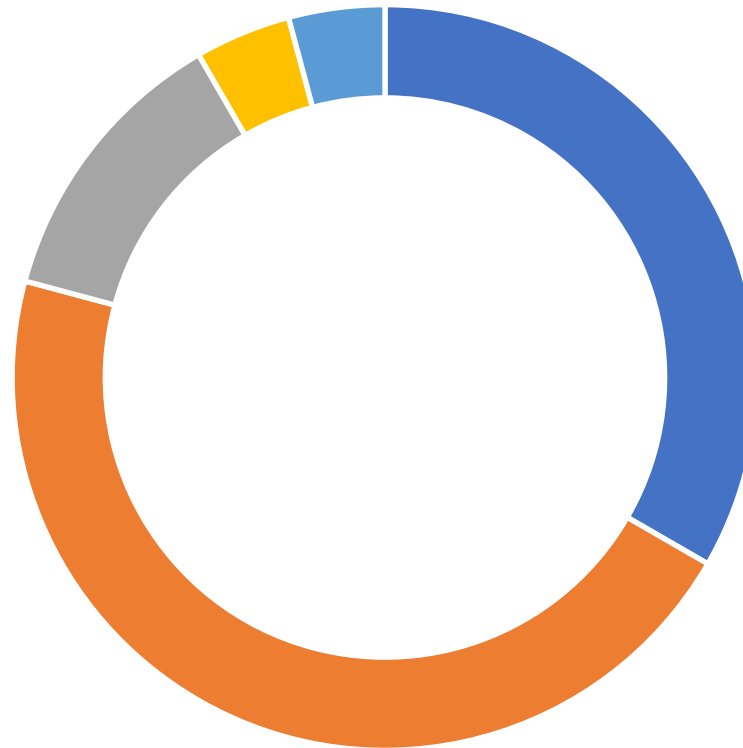


■ High ■ Medium ■ Low ■ No Vote

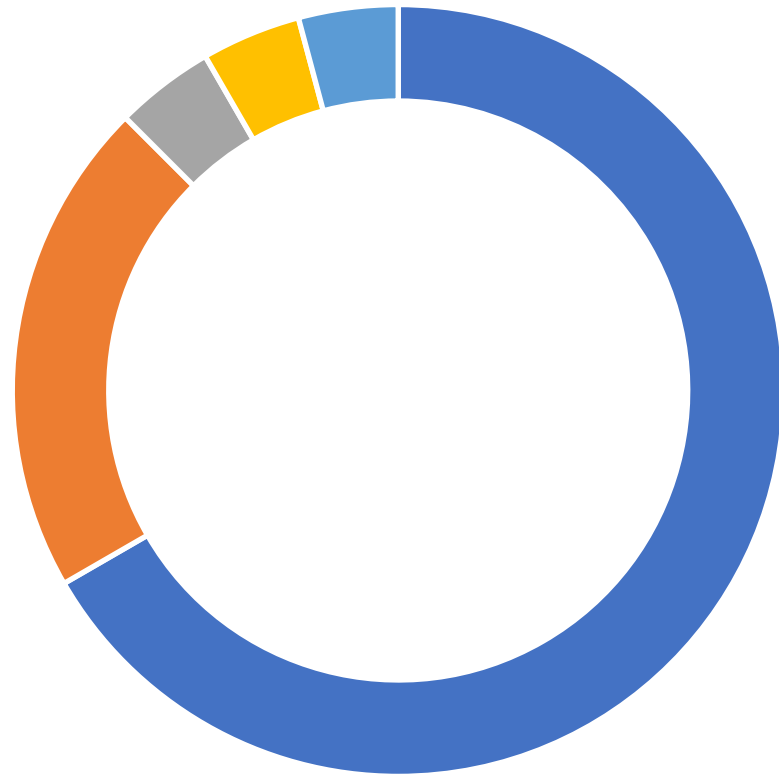


■ High ■ Medium ■ Low ■ Lack Information ■ NoVote

What ideas or suggestions do you have which might be helpful to the leadership in making these important decisions?

- Take a breather until maybe the end of 2019 before the asking-for-money phase of the campaign would begin.
- Reducing expenses long term by efficiency and consolidation seems really important.
- Consider breaking down the expand sacristy, upgrade nursery, create Godly play room into phases. For example, I think upgrading nursery is higher priority than expand sacristy given the number of babies and toddlers in our parish. The growing young families in our congregation is exciting and I view this a high priority to support them. If we break up the renovations of the old parish hall into the smallest chunks possible, this may help us reach our goals sooner.
- Regarding furnishing, it would be helpful to see a list of all things, big or small that are needed. That way people could sign their name next to an item they can provide.
- Go ahead and move the office to the old parish hall and rent out the old office space as income to help fund the fund raising for all of the projects.

Continued... leadership recommendations

- My rationale for ranking office space as a high priority and sacristy/nursery/classroom as a medium priority: moving offices from the house on Farmer frees up the house for residential use, if we need to move students out of Canterbury House.
- Why is landscaping not listed, we can't continue to have mud, the eyesore of the neighborhood. Is there a plan that I am not aware of?? And the lake in our gravel parking lot.....can we get a few loads of gravel to make this useable? Playground, expansion?? Not complaining asking if plans are in place and what is proposed.
- Consider refinancing the office to help bridge any gap if fundraising doesn't meet the \$100k goal

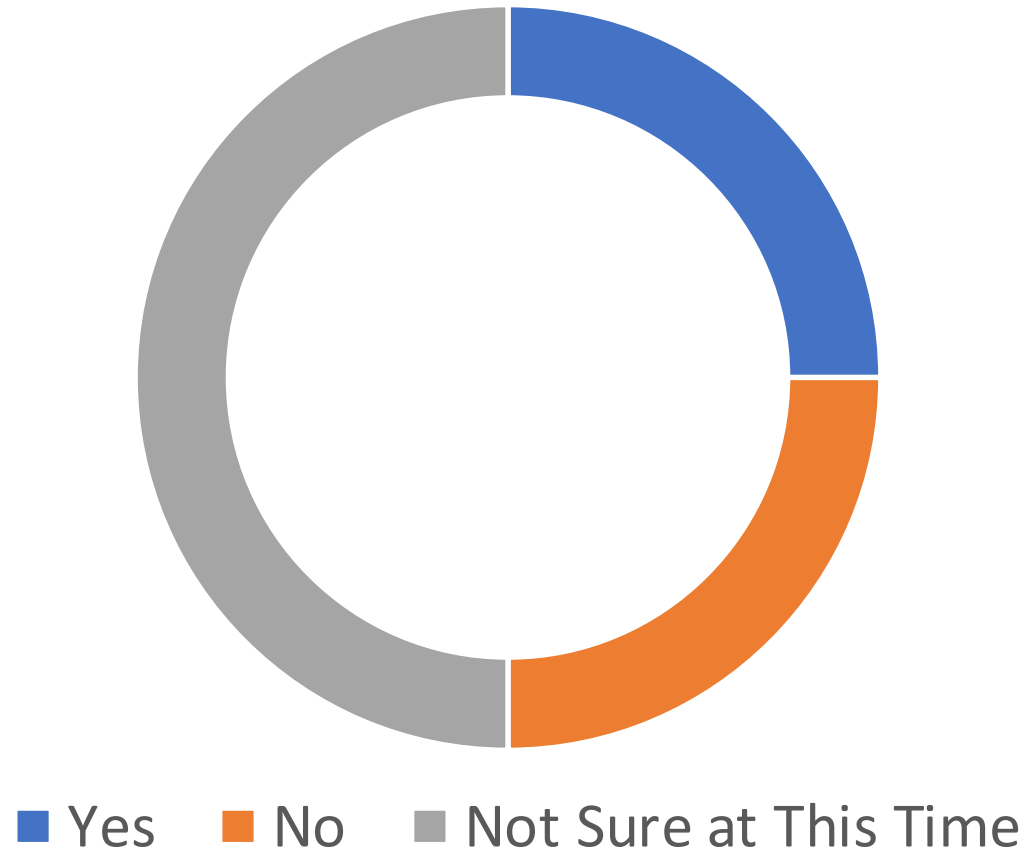
If asked, would you be willing to work on a committee in support of the proposed fundraising effort?

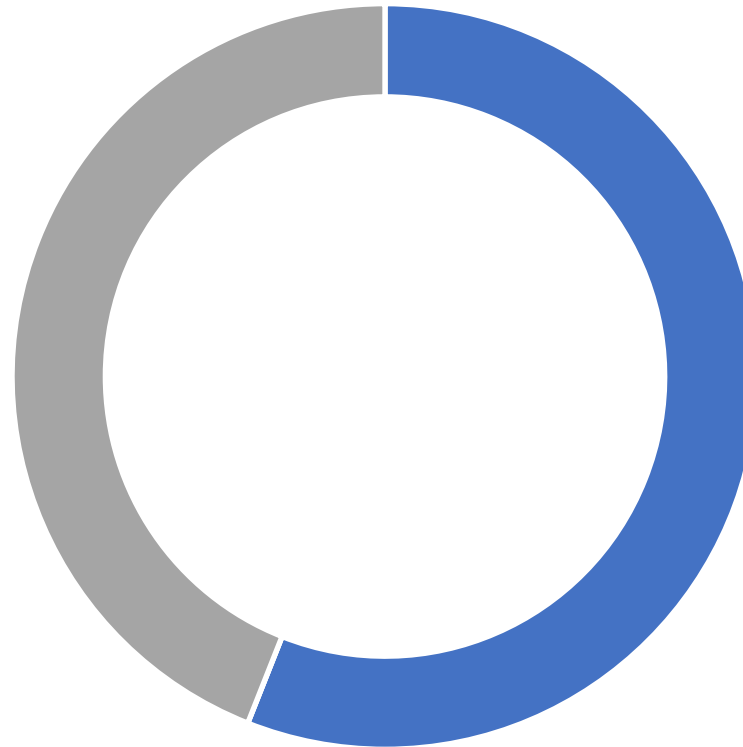
Do you think that a goal of \$100,000 (as outlined in the proposed plans) can be raised in gifts and pledges?

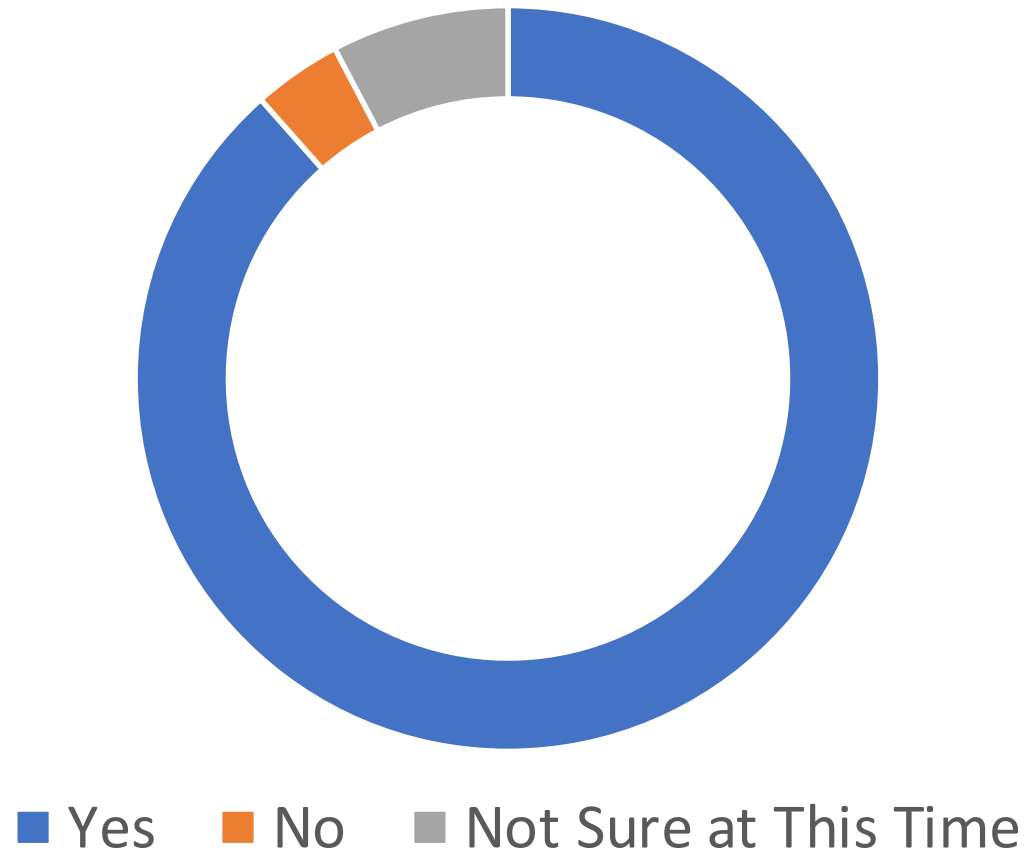
